Participants to bring their own equipment – as follows;

Artists paper (large sheets of Arches 300 gsm can be purchased at the workshop below whole sale price)
Brushes size 2 to 000 (can also be purchased at the workshop)

Watercolours – the essentials are;

Winsor and Newton Professional Artists Tubes

Permanent Sap Green (Series 1A)

Cadmium Yellow

Burnt Sienna (Series 1AA)

Titanium White (Series 1)

Ivory Black (or Lamp Black Series 1AA)

Permanent or Cobalt Blue (deep) 4AA

Participants would need to bring their own lights (preferably a daytime globe), desk easels, water pots and mixing bowls.



Also, a small dried specimen such as a gumnut or leaf for beginners, or a native plant cutting for intermediate/advanced artists.

Penny will also be bringing some of her framed work with a 25% discount for workshop participants.
